Worship:

Once a week, students from all grades come together for a communal worship experience. We love these opportunities to reflect on our core values and build a sense of spiritual community.

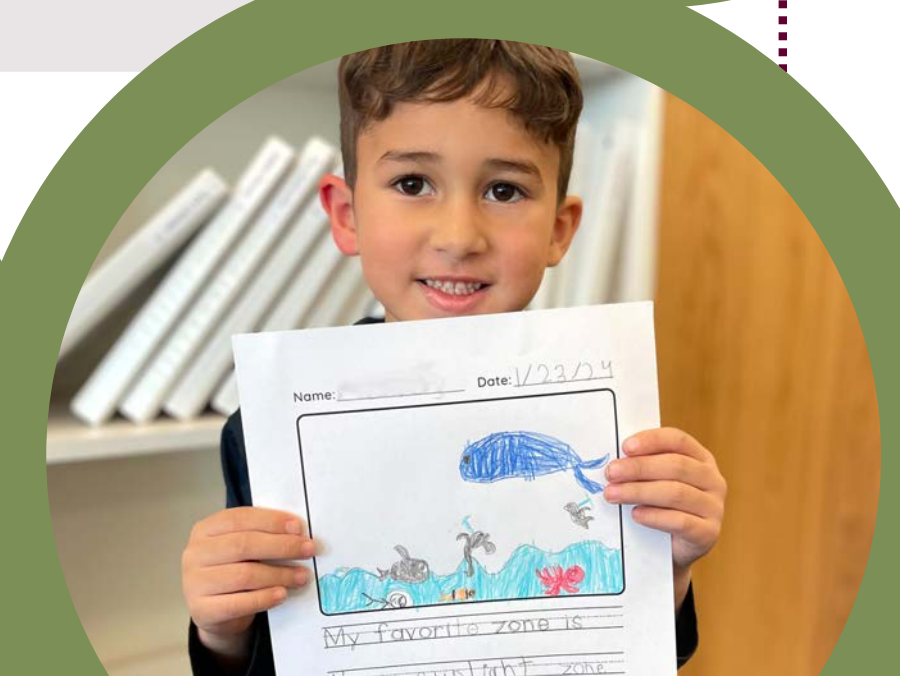
Buddies

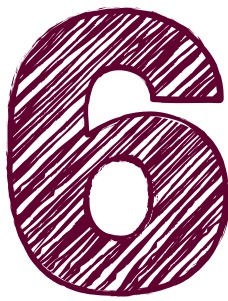
Kindergartners are partnered with a student from the upper elementary. Throughout the year, the buddies get together for socializing, crafting, games and science experiments.

1

Read aloud to your child every day. Any exposure to literacy will be beneficial.

2

Teach your child to recognize, spell and write their name.

3

Help your child become independent and able to take care of their own restroom needs, including zipping and buttoning their clothes.

4

Give your child experiences away from you (staying at a friends house, visiting relatives, etc.)

5

Expose your child to letters and numbers whenever possible. Make it fun and light hearted.

6

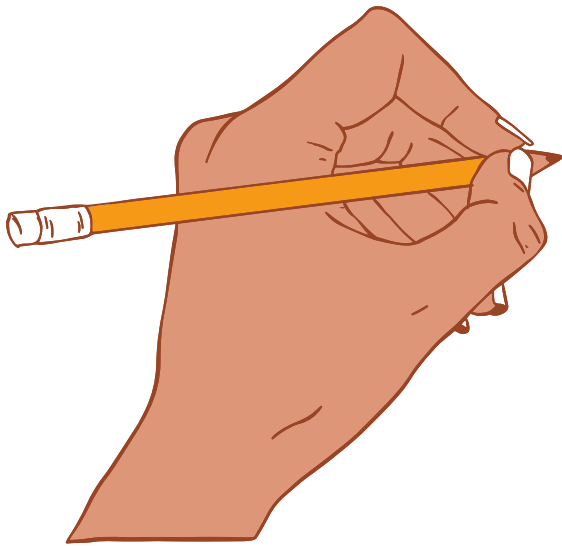
Strengthen your child's grip and fine motor skills. Encourage your child to model shapes with play dough. Cut up old magazines to practice cutting skills.

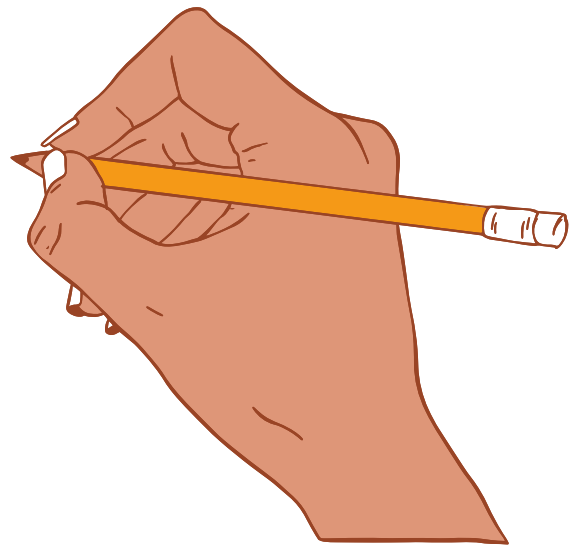
PENCIL GRIP

right hand

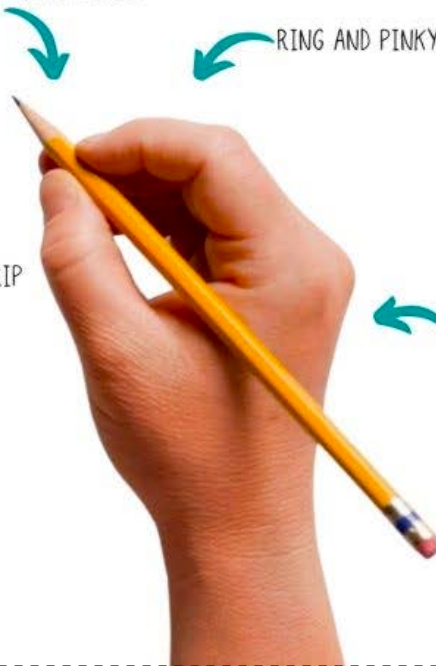


MIDDLE FINGER SUPPORTS PENCIL

RING AND PINKY FINGER TUCKED UNDER

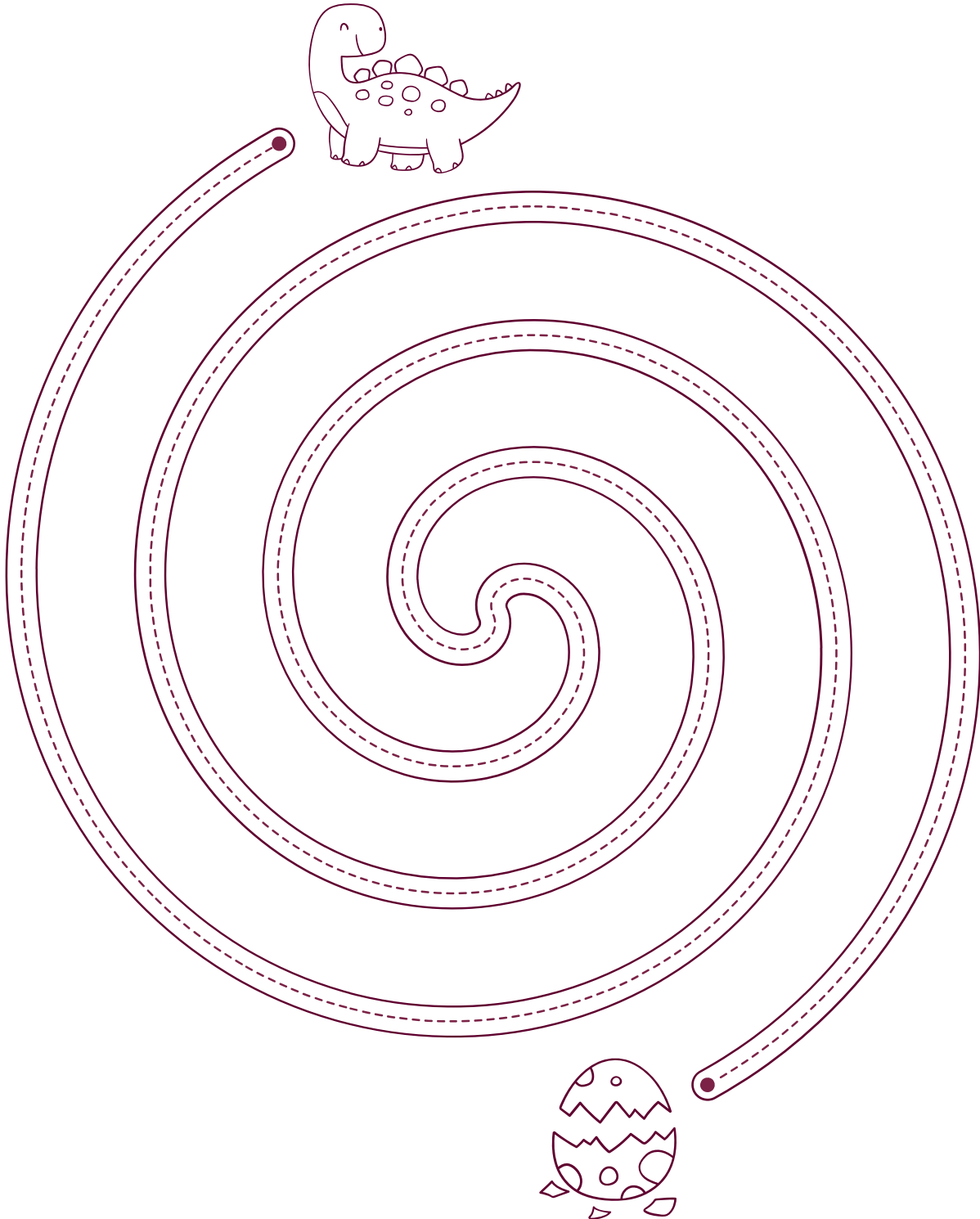
CHOOSE THE RIGHT PLACE TO GRIP

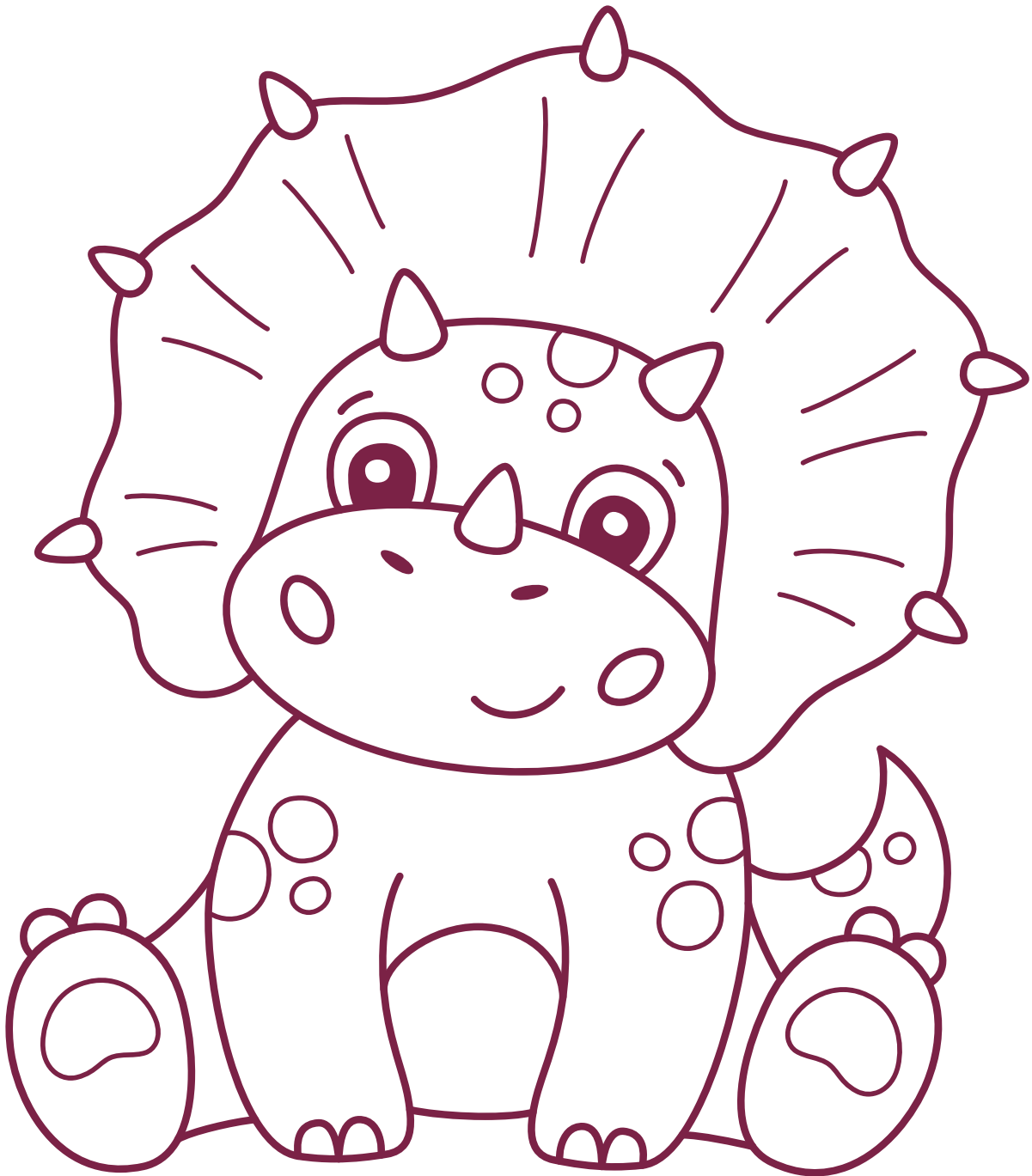




FINE MOTOR SKILLS
